

[Pass control regime has been introduced](#) in Moscow **since April 15**, everyone who travels by personal or public transport in Moscow **will have to have a pass**. [Read the decree in Russian](#).

You can still walk without a pass, but at the same time strictly observing the rules and restrictions established earlier.

Issuing digital passes will take place from Monday, April 13, 2020.

Digital pass – this is a digital code that can be printed or presented electronically on your smartphone along with your ID card. Control will be carried out by a special patrol. Proof of identity is required.

The purpose of travel and validity of passes:

1. For traveling from home to work and back and moving around the city as part of the performance of official duties. If the work duties cannot be performed remotely (issued before April 30, 2020). NB: The organization should have the right to continue its work.
2. For travels to a medical organization (issued for an entire day an unlimited number of times a week)
3. One-time travel for other purposes (issued for one trip no more than 2 times a week)

Three ways to apply for a pass:

1. Fill out an electronic application on www.mos.ru
2. Send SMS to 7377
3. Call +7 495 777 77 77

Information that must be provided to get a pass:

- purpose of travel,
- family name, first name, patronymic (if any),
- document type and document number,
- vehicle registration plate number or Troika/Strelka card number (if any).
- for work passes — TIN of the organization, for visiting a medical institution — the name of the institution.

In case of violation of the pass control regime when traveling on transport, the violator will be fined 5,000 RUB.
