

On April 10, Moscow Mayor Sergey Sobyenin [warned](#) of the **gradual introduction of a permit system to control movement throughout the city.**

Further it is planned to limit travels for other purposes, if necessary, for movement within the city district. These stages will be announced **later**.

The procedure for issuing passes has not yet been clarified.

In addition, **a number of additional prohibitions and restrictions [will be introduced](#) in Moscow from April 13 to April 19, 2020.**

1. The work of almost all enterprises and organizations is temporarily suspended. **Except for:**

- food and retail stores that are still open;
- bodies of state power;
- medical organizations;
- food and medical industry enterprises;
- personal protective equipment manufacturers;
- key enterprises of the defense industry, space and nuclear industry;
- critical infrastructure enterprises;
- structures that ensure payment of wages.

All operating companies should minimize the number of employees present at the workplace. Remaining employees are transferred to remote work or to a non-working week.

2. Construction (repair) works are suspended, except for the construction of medical facilities and transport infrastructure.

3. Carsharing service is suspended.

4. The provision of medical services by organizations and individual entrepreneurs for which this type of activity is not the main one is suspended.

5. A temporary regime for the execution of the city budget is introduced, which suspends the Contracting of any purchases other than urgent one.
