

On March 25-26, the Moscow city Hall and the Moscow region Government introduced new restrictions in connection with COVID-19.

New restrictions introduced by the Moscow city Hall on March 25-26

Decree of March 26:

From March 28 to April 5, 2020, additional restrictions will be imposed on the operation of enterprises and organizations with mass visits of people.

1. Restaurants, cafes, bars, canteens and other public catering establishments are suspended, with the exception of take-away service without visiting premises and remote delivery of ready meals.
2. Retail outlets are temporarily shut down, with the exception of pharmacies and drugstores, as well as the sale of any food products and certain types of non-food necessities. Food stores and pharmacies will operate without restrictions. The list of non-food essential goods can be read here.
3. Citizens are temporarily stopped visiting territories of citywide significance: VDNH, Central Park of The city of Moscow. Gorky Park, Tsaritsyno and Kolomenskoye nature reserves, Zaryadye Park, Sokolniki Pcio, and Kuskovo estate Museum.
4. Must be temporarily stopped to provide citizens with services that require personal presence of the person (for example, hairdressing). Exceptions to this rule are medical, rehabilitation services, care for the elderly and other persons in need, other social services, transport services, banking and insurance services, housing and communications services, and funeral services. There are no restrictions on providing services remotely or by courier delivery.
5. Recommendations to refrain from visiting religious sites.
6. The temporary cancellation of free public transport will not affect students who work or volunteer.

Valid until the order to cancel the restrictive measures by the Mayor's office.

Earlier, the following restrictive measures were taken by the decree of March 25:

1. City libraries and cultural and leisure institutions-cultural centers, clubs, etc. - are temporarily closed.
2. Cinemas, cinemas, children's entertainment centers and game rooms are temporarily closed.
3. The activity of night clubs, discos and other entertainment and leisure establishments has been temporarily suspended.
4. A ban on smoking hookahs in restaurants, bars, cafes and other similar facilities is being introduced.
5. To suspend any cultural, recreational, sports, entertaining, educational, exhibition, advertising and other leisure activities, including using theme, parks of culture and rest, shopping centers and other

places of mass visiting citizens – indoors and outdoors. Children's rooms, cinemas, fitness clubs, ice rinks, bowling alleys, billiard rooms, amusement rides, water parks and other recreational facilities should be closed in shopping and entertainment centers. Animators should not engage with children, and promoters should not conduct presentations of products and services. Stores, banks and household services located in the shopping center remain open.

6. Dental offices will only provide emergency care for acute pain and other urgent conditions.

7. The "My documents" public service centers will go into operation by appointment and will only provide services that cannot be obtained in electronic form.

8. The suspension of free travel on public transport applies to students of colleges and universities, as well as to the elderly over 65 years of age and citizens suffering from chronic diseases.

Restrictions imposed by the Governor of the Moscow region:

From March 28 to April 5:

1. the operation of restaurants, cafes, canteens, buffets, bars, eateries and other public catering establishments has been suspended, with the exception of take-away service without visiting the premises of citizens of the premises of such enterprises, as well as delivery of orders;
2. suspended retail facilities, with the exception of drugstores and pharmacies and retailers in the realization of food products and (or) non-food Essentials and excluding sale of goods remote way, including with the condition of delivery;
3. the operation of beauty salons, beauty salons, SPAS, massage parlors, tanning salons, saunas and other facilities that provide such services that involve the presence of a citizen in person has been suspended, with the exception of services provided remotely, including with the condition of delivery."

Valid until the order to cancel restrictive measures by the Governor of the Moscow region.
